DOOR COUNTY COOPERATIVE OWNERS RECEIVE CASH DIVIDENDS

Sturgeon Bay, WI – May 24, 2022. The 82nd annual Shareholders Meeting of the Door County Cooperative will be held on Tuesday, June 28, 2022 beginning at 5:00 p.m. Our annual meeting will be broadcast online and you can watch the proceedings live on the Cooperatives' Facebook page.

On May 24th, the Cooperative began the mailing of over 3,750 patronage dividend checks to members that supported in Co-op in 2021. The distribution of over \$580,000.00 is equivalent to nearly a 3% refund on qualifying member purchases.

Members receiving dividend checks will also be supplied with a copy of the minutes of the 81st annual meeting and voting ballots to allow them to participate in the governance of their Cooperative.

Members are encouraged to complete their ballots and return them to the Co-op by June 20th. All voting ballots received will also be entered into a drawing for door prizes, which will include a grand prize of a \$500 Door County Cooperative gift card.
